

YHS-NHS NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY RESIGNATION AND DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

RESIGNATION: There sometimes are situations in which members feel the need to resign from the National Honor Society. A member wishing to resign must type a letter to the NHS Faculty Council requesting to resign. The letter must be dated and signed by the student and parent/guardian. The Faculty Council votes on the resignation.

DISMISSAL: The Faculty Council will determine dismissal of members. Prior to a dismissal a Dismissal Hearing will be held. Members who fall below the standards which were the basis for their selection shall be warned in writing by the chapter adviser and given a reasonable amount of time to correct the deficiency. If the deficiency is due to scholarship the Faculty Council shall determine that a probation period of one quarter is a reasonable warning period for academic probation. Disciplinary probation periods shall be determined by the Faculty Council. In case of flagrant violation of school rules or civil laws, a member does not necessarily have to be warned. Meetings are **MANDATORY**. Students may miss two out of the eight scheduled meetings. (Missing a meeting should be reserved for illness or an extenuating circumstance.) After the first absence a warning is issued. After the second absence another warning is issued. At the third absence a Dismissal Hearing before the Faculty Council is called. All members who have been dismissed may appeal their dismissal before the principal.
